## The new WALTHER Line

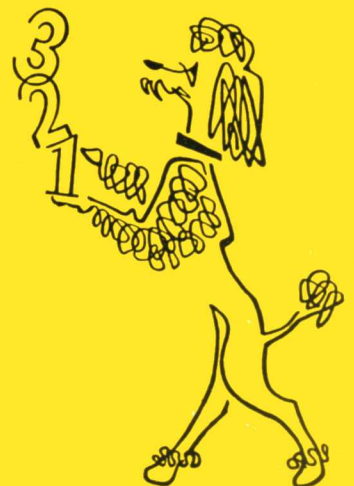

The Simplex adds, subtracts, and prints Debit or Credit balances at an operating speed of 230 cycles per minute. Multiplication is performed rapidly and easily by means of repeated addition. Items and answers are printed on the tape in large legible figures. The Simplex is the ideal answer to general purpose figurework.

insulated and radio screened.

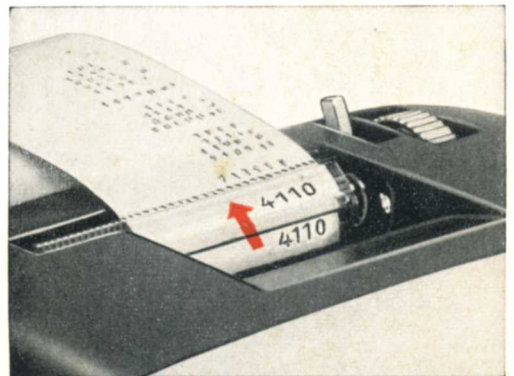
